Where does our money go?

- 20 Staff F.T.E
- $932k \div 20 =$
46k contribution per staff member to City
- Remove salary costs.....every person that works here **brings c25k per year** to the City over and above their salary.
- **Half a million ££££££££!!!s.**
- PCVS giving back to Peterborough.

Value for money?

- City Council contribution – 40k
- $932K \div 40K =$

Return on investment -

- **£23,000 per City Council £1000!**

Next Year?

- PP Social Prescribing = £7m external funding for Peterborough over 5 years
- **£1.5m p.a**
- PP BBO = c£1m Lottery funding over 3 years - **£300k p.a**
- Total PP/PCVS forecast 19/20 annual income - **£2.6m**
- Value per member of staff?**£115k**
